## News from the Board of Directors

The Board met in January at the house of the Boss, Robert Alsaker, to review the Torske Klub functions and make decisions critical to our operations. From this meeting, the board has the following significant announcements to the Torske Klub:

- *Financial* The Torske Klub is in good financial shape, much thanks to the contributions of the raffle and the participation of the members. *Late Reservations* The Torske Klub will impose a \$5.00 late fee for any reservation made after the deadline of 12 noon on the Tuesday before any dinner. This should encourage a majority of the reservations to enable a proper fish order, but still allows those who choose to call late. This is not an exoneration to call late, but a further encouragement
- to call early. This fee will be re-evaluated periodically. *Ladies Day 2008* To separate the Ladies Day from the traditional Torske Klub Anniversary month, the Board has elected to move Ladies day to the month of February starting in 2008. Ladies day in 2007 will be next May as previously announced. Father/Son/Daughter day will continue to be held in March.
- Lefse The Lefse from Countryside Lefse has been a very successful addition to the dinner. One box (12 packs of 8 pieces) is typically ordered for dinner. Last month, we experimented by ordering two boxes and selling the remainder for \$5 per pack. We will continue to do this first come, first serve at the dinner.
