Norwegian Ambassador Visits Chicago

The membership of the Chicago Torske Klub was well represented at the recent Norwegian American Chamber of Commerce (NACC) dinner for the new Norwegian Ambassador to the U.S, his Excellency, Wegger Christian Strommen, his wife and daughters. The September 26 event was black tie optional at the Drake Hotel in downtown Chicago, kicked off by our good member Paul Anderson and moderated by Broadcast Hall of Famer from WGN, Orion Samuelson.

Among the attendees, were our members the Hon. Consul General Paul Anderson, Consul General emeritus Per Ohrstrom, Pastor David Langseth, who provided the invocation, Peter Nielsen, whose wife Martha is NACC president, Lowell Olberg (NACC VP), Wisconsin Hon. Consul General Trygve Lonnebottn (honorary Torske Klub member and boss emeritus of the Madison Torske Klub), Hank Solberg, Bill Scheiderich, Hugo Lanneskog, Julian Ronning, Robert Alsaker (our boss), Don Hoganson (our assistant boss), Ken Larson (our secretary) and many dignitaries from Chicago and the consulates of Denmark & Finland .
