# Start of the Annual Dues Collection for the 2011 Season

October has been the official time of the year that we start the dues collection for the 2011 year. Enclosed is a membership form for the 2010-2011 season with your member information that you have supplied previously. If it is incorrect, please enter your corrections or omissions. We get a fair number of questions about the dues and form. Here are some frequently asked questions:

- Why do we collect dues at all? In the past decades, the Torske Klub collected a few dollars for the mailing reminder, some stationary and on the month of your birthday you paid a fee for the aquavit. That was a collection nightmare at the check-in, so we bundled the fees together, now \$40 per year.
- Can I pay at the luncheon? Of course. Either provide a separate check, or bundle your dues payment with your meal. Many members save on the postage and bring their dues and form to the check-in table. [Don't do this at the October Formal dinner, however, we won't be collecting money that day]
- Do I need to send back the form? If the dues are paid and the information is correct, don't go to extraordinary effort to return the form.
- I have never paid dues, why am I getting a letter and dues request? There are two reasons. First, we send out a number of complimentary letters to friends of the Torske Klub and leaders of other organizations. Your slip of paper is to correct our records if needed. Second, we have a number of people identified as potential members who signed up at Vasa Park or other places. You are welcome to use the addressed envelope to join us. Please also complete the information you wish to supply.
- How much information do you need? Minimally, we need your name, address and birth month for our mailing and birthday recognition. Those with email supplied will get an email reminder of the meetings and additional Klub news between letters. Phone numbers are rarely needed, but occasionally we need to call to clarify a reservation or membership question.
- I forgot to pay! Am I dropped as a member?- No problem, we collect dues in
  October, November and December and all are members in good standing
  until December 31. In January, we send a friendly reminder. We usually
  keep the mailing going for awhile more, but eventually the mail will stop.
- Why do you need my birth date? We only need the month to acknowledge your birthday but when the meeting date falls on your birthday or if you have a special decade to celebrate, we can sometimes have fun with your special day in the letter or the meeting.
- Do you distribute this information to others? Not outside the Klub. The membership information is entrusted to the board of directors. If you check the box to "not publish" your information we will hold your information to all others, including other members. Otherwise, if a member requests a phone number or other member contact we will provide it. We have published a directory of Torske Klub to our members occasionally.
- When do you issue 2011 membership cards? We do this typically in January for paid members.

#### Did You Know?

The cost of the stamp in our first Klub reminder postcard in 1960 was 3¢. A letter would have been 4¢. We currently pay 46¢ for each letter.
