What does the Fylkesmann Do?

Lodve Solholm, our good friend Svein Ludvigsen, and 16 other Norwegians have been appointed to the role of "Fylkesmannen" or County (fylke) Governor for each of the 18 counties that make up Norway. This office is an executive branch posting which is formally appointed by the King of Norway in a cabinet meeting. Essentially, these people are representatives of the King and they connect the state and municipalities.

They are responsible for civil matters such as marriage and divorce, and they regulate agriculture, forestry and environmental matters among other duties. Occasionally they need to intervene in financial matters of municipalities. A Fylkesmann is appointed for one six year term and he can serve a second six year term, but he must retire at

the age of 70. Our friend Svein has recently stepped down from his position after about 13 years. Although it sounds like a political office, and many fylkesmann are former politicians, they do not participate in partisan politics. Ref: Wikipedia.org & Lowell Olberg
