



April Luncheon Presents "The Shetland Bus"

For this first luncheon of spring, we welcome Jon Satrum to our speaker's podium. He will be speaking about "The Shetland Bus". This was the nickname of a clandestine special operations group providing a permanent link between Shetland, Scotland, and German-occupied Norway from 1941-1945.

A key part of this group were the volunteer Norwegian fishermen sailing in the worst weather, at the worst time of year (winter), in the dark, to avoid being spotted by the German defenses. The missions were mainly to supply the Norwegian resistance movement and rescue those who needed to escape from the Nazis.

In retirement, Jon Satrum focuses on a variety of personal interests and all things Norwegian. A member of multiple Norwegian heritage organizations, he is active in his Sons of Norway lodge, and on the Board of Directors of Trønderlag of America. This organization has participated in events at Nidaros Cathedral in Norway, set up a fund to repair Nidaros Cathedral's Steinmeyer organ and much more. Recall that Jon spoke to us in 2013 about Roald Amundsen, and has spoken at many nordic events in the Chicago area. Our torskemaster will be Greg LeDuc.
