Torsk Season Launches with Sloopers



Sloopers are the descendants of the first Norwegians who sailed from Norway to the United States in 1825. These early pioneers came to America on a 54-foot sloop in search of opportunity and freedom. They have since been known as "Sloopers"

The 2015-2016 Chicago Torske Klub luncheon season launches in September with a presentation by Wesley Hougsted. Pastor Hougsted is a retired United Methodist minister after serving churches in Northern Illinois for 34 years. He is currently a resident of Arlington Heights with some wintering in Florida.
