# Cultural Heritage for Father/Son/Daughter Day

We are pleased to welcome Mr. Baard Titlestad to our speaker's podium for our annual celebration of Father, Son and Daughter Day. He will speak about the topic: "Preserve and persevere in a brave new world: Thoughts on the importance and relevance of cultural heritage in

In 2014, the first volume of *Flateyjarbok*, a translation of the largest and most enigmatic saga manuscript created in Iceland, was published in Norway to great public acclaim. Led by Mr. Titlestad, an international team had worked for years to create an unprecedented campaign to disseminate and preserve a rare cultural gem for future generations, at a cost of more than \$600,000. The importance of the work was acknowledged by HM King Harald of Norway, HM Queen Margrethe of Denmark and HE President Olafur Ragnar Grimsson of Iceland, all of whom wrote prefaces to the book. Along the way, he learned many valuable lessons about the significance of cultural heritage, the importance of preserving it and how connecting the past, present and future, brings people together and rekindles the ancient wisdom. In this lecture, Baard will also talk about some of the challenges and rewards that comes

with being involved in this work. He hopes that sharing his experiences will inspire the listeners in their own pursuits in the field of heritage and tradition.
