## lrish, ye say?

As we have written ad nauseum in the past 15 years about the Norwegian Viking contribution to Ireland, the origin of Dublin and Waterford (from Old Norse Veðrafjorðr, meaning "ram (wether) fjord"), etc., we'll leave that alone this month. Let's embrace our Irish ancestors and cousins this month and explore the phrases we have used to greet each other on March 17, aka St. Paddy's Day.

• Erin Go Bragh—It is supposed to be "Ireland Forever". It sounds Gaelic, but not quite. Erin is the Anglicization of the Irish word Éireann which translates literally to "Of Ireland"; the actual word in Irish for just plain "Ireland" is Éire. The remainder of the phrase is more of a challenge.

There is no "Bragh" in the Irish language. Go brách means for ever, but if you mispronounce it as "Brach", that means pus. Go it seems like you may get an odd look or a beer in the face if we utter that in Ireland.

- **Top O' The Mornin'** Those that traveled Ireland say they have never heard this uttered; more usually "Hi", or "Hiya".
- **Begosh and Begorrah** A little Google-digging reveals that the word begorrah may have its origins in the 18th century or earlier; perhaps as a euphemism for "by God". The closest Irish word may be Goradh which means heat or heating (rinne mé a goradh cois tine translates as "I warmed myself by the fire"). We're not sure if this is legit in Ireland either.
